PERMIT FOR BAEL AND CURRY PLANTS
CITRUS NURSERY STOCK PEST CLEANLINESS PROGRAM

Under authority of Title 3, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 3154, Secretary May Issue Special Permits, Section 3701.2, Program Responsibilities, permission is granted to:

to authorize seeds of bael and curry plants to be planted inside departmentally approved insect-resistant structures, which would otherwise be prohibited by Title 3, CCR, Section 3701.4, Planting Location and Maintenance Requirements, under the following conditions:

1. The originating bael and curry plants shall be maintained by the University of California at Riverside's Citrus Clonal Protection Program and the USDA's National Clonal Germplasm Repository for Citrus and Dates.
2. The originating bael and curry plant source trees shall be tested by staff at these facilities and found apparently free from harmful diseases.
3. Initially, only the seed from the originating source trees shall be planted within departmentally approved insect-resistant structures.
4. Once plants have been established from seed within the departmentally approved insect-resistant structures nursery stock may be vegetatively propagated within these structures from these plants.
5. No bael or curry plants which have left the departmentally approved insect-resistant structures may be returned to the structure.

Unless earlier suspended or revoked for noncompliance, this permit is valid through October 31, 2017.
