PERMIT FOR PCR PROTOCOL FOR VIRUS TESTING IN  
CITRUS NURSERY STOCK PEST CLEANLINESS PROGRAM

Under authority of Title 3, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 3154, Secretary May Issue Special Permits, permission is granted to:

to authorize the use of the attached PCR protocol for Citrus tristeza virus (CTV), Citrus psorosis virus (CPsV), and Citrus leaf blotch virus (CLBV) detection for citrus mother tree registration as part of the Citrus Nursery Stock Pest Cleanliness Program, which would otherwise be prohibited by Title 3, CCR, 3701.6, Inspection and Testing Procedures for members of the Citrus Clonal Protection Program, the Central California Tristeza Eradication Agency and the Jerry Dimitman Laboratory.

Unless earlier suspended or revoked for noncompliance, this permit is valid through October 31, 2017.
